This did not appear to phase most of the competitors who seemed to go away happy.

Sorry for the lack of on the day results and the hick up with some of the earlier preliminary results posted on the web. The damp weather must have affected the computer system.

Planner's comments - *Dave Caudwell*

Despite the appalling weather, everyone I spoke to after their runs seemed to enjoy their courses (with one exception!), and the winning times didn't seem any longer than what was expected. Someone likened the experience to that of running through a paddy field, and a comment I heard time after time was "When you're wet, you're wet..."

One small gripe - I'm amazed at the number of people who appear not to read the final details. Surely, if it says in the final details that walls must not be crossed (our use of the area depends on this), then they shouldn't be crossed, and it shouldn't be necessary to cover the map in purple un-crossable boundary lines, yet there were reports of competitors attempting (and sometimes succeeding) to go over them.

My thanks are due to all those NN members who helped and particularly the control collection team who braved the elements again to get the controls back in.

Thanks are also due to Peter Fawcett of Bollihope Estates for permission to use the area, and Michael Gibbs, the local keeper for his help and unfailingly good advice.

Controller's comments - *Rob McKenna*

Not really a lot to add to Dave's comments as the courses seem to have been just about right and were well received, the organisation appeared to work well given the weather conditions.

We did have one complaint from a lady on the green course who felt that her first control was a bit of a bingo control and that the kite should have been hung a little higher. Whilst I took her point that depressions can be looked at this way, the control was only about 300m from the start and did have other features close by to identify the position.
